- Complete an Undergraduate Student Petition - Fill out a separate petition for each course that you are petitioning Attach course syllabus.
- Submit completed petition(s) & syllabus to the Global Health Advisor (The form can scanned and sent via email to [ghpadvising@ucsd.edu](mailto:ghpadvising@ucsd.edu) or dropped off in the GHP Office)
- You will be notified via the Virtual Advising Center (<http://vac.ucsd.edu>) once your petition has been approved (please allow 2 weeks before contacting advisor)
