- Submit completed petition(s) & syllabus to the Global Health Advisor (The form can scanned and sent via email to ghpadvising@ucsdedu or dropped off in the GHP Office)
- You will be notified via the Virtual Advising Center (<u>http://vac.ucsd.edu</u>) once your petition has been approved (please allow 2 weeks before contacting advisor)
