Education Abroad Program

Program Overview

The Geneva Global and International Studies program is an interdisciplinary semester program designed for students seeking an enriching academic experience in one of the world's major centers for international governance. The academically challenging program provides a series of interdisciplinary course modules taught in English that include academic field trips to the many Geneva-based organizations, such as the United Nations, the World Trade Organization, the World Health Organization and the International Labor Organization. Includes a course, Concepts and Controversies in Global Health.

A full-time two month summer internship is an option for students who would like to extend their program in Geneva after the spring semester. Internship placements are offered in local international organizations, NGOs, and permanent missions in Geneva. See reverse for recent internship sites.

Language of Instruction: English, French

Students with minimal to no prior French will take courses in English. Students with at least 2 years of college level French may choose to take some of their courses in French.

Duration

Spring semester: mid February to late June Spring semester + Summer internship: mid February to mid August

Total Cost: Financial aid applies; study abroad scholarships available

Spring semester: \$16,050 Spring semester + Summer internship: \$21,450

Eligibility

Class Level: Junior, Senior GPA: 3.0 cumulative GPA at the time of application and maintained through the end of the last term prior to departure.

Other Eligibility Requirements: University of Geneva applicants are required to have taken at least 3 upper division courses in the social sciences prior to departure.
