- On each petition include the course # (as it appears on TritonLink), course title, # of units, grade
  received, quarter/semester the course was taken, the University in which you were enrolled and specify the
  requirement you want to apply the course toward (e.g. Fulfill Global Health Major Elective Requirement).
  Please also sign and date the petition.
- Submit completed petition(s) & syllabus to the Global Health Advisor (The form can scanned and sent via email to <a href="mailto:ghpadvising@ucsd.edu">ghpadvising@ucsd.edu</a> or dropped off in the <a href="mailto:GHP Office">GHP Office</a>).
